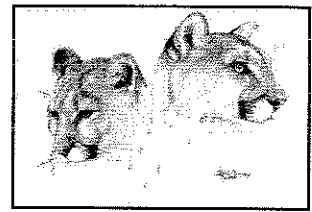

We are pleased to have Detective Scott Streltsoff from the Spokane County Sheriff's Office presenting information on cyberbullying and internet safety. The presentation is scheduled for Wednesday, February 15 from 6:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. in the Medical Lake Middle School library.

The presentation will focus on internet safety issues that our youth are exposed and vulnerable to on a daily basis. It will include: cyberbullying, awareness of internet predators, and the implications with youth accessing social media networks. School personnel will also be present to discuss MLSD's policies and procedures related to harassment, intimidation, and bullying. Detective Streltsoff will share what the Sheriff's Office can do to help keep children safe and what laws are in place to protect them. This presentation is for parents and guardians only. Students will be receiving an age-appropriate presentation from School Resource Officer Deputy Travis Pendell during the school day.
